### Affirming her child



Mary's teenager Sam had been struggling with depression due to gender dysphoria, along with other challenges within their school environment. After three written recommendations and completing prior-authorizations for gender affirmation surgery, the family's insurance provider denied coverage for the procedure.

#### Here's how Wellthy helped:

- Produced a comprehensive appeal package
- Gathered documentation of doctoral letters, along with supporting scholar documents
- Supported with a United Civil Rights Complaint via the Department of Health and Human Services
- Found and recommended post-treatment support groups and counseling

**Highlight:** Sam's procedure was ultimately approved and Mary's employer changed their policy for future approvals. Mary shared, "I really wish I could hug and kiss you right now. Just told a coworker and we are both crying. I cannot thank you enough".

## Finding care for themself
